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Antonym Go Fish game! I use this game with my higher first grade students during phonics time as a center. They love this game and it gets them thinking about the meaning of words as

> they read! I like to laminate each set for future use. I added some fun cards to this game. If a student picks one of these cards from the "go fish" pile, they follow the directions on the card. Students should not start with these cards. Enjoy

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Directions:

- 1. Deal out 4 cards to each player. (Make sure players don't start with cards that have sad faces or fishes on them.)
- 2. Put the extra cards in a pile in the middle.
- 3. Look at your cards and take turns asking...Do you have a word with the opposite meaning as...?
- 4. If the other player doesn't, take a card from the "go fish" pile.
- 5. If you make a match, put it to the side.
- 6. If you draw a card with a sad face on it, give one of your matches to another player.
- If you draw a card with a fish on it_{ℓ} 7. draw another card.
- 8. The player with the most matches at the end WINS!


