Pass The Beat

This is a fun game for all the family and it can also be played with friends, once you make sure you are social distancing properly!

- Everybody sits in a circle.
- The words are: PASS-THE-BEAT-A-ROUND-THE-ROOM and each person says one word (if you have 7 people playing) or else some people might end up saying two words if you go around the circle once and haven't finished the sentence.
- Practice going around the circle with each person saying the word, then speed it up. Keep a rhythm to it. If any player stumbles when they're supposed to say their word and the beat gets dropped, they are out.
- Next, replace one of the words with a body percussion action, for example, instead of a person saying "BEAT", they do a stamp instead. So, it becomes "PASS-THE-[STAMP]-A-ROUND-THE-ROOM. Speed it up again and see if everyone can keep the beat.
- Replace another word and so on, until there are no more players left.
